Let's meet for a hike to Little Yosemite in Sunol Wilderness Regional Preserve. It's about a two-mile round-trip hike, on a wide dirt road, from the parking lot to the granite-filled Alameda Creek and back.

After you enter the preserve, please continue driving to the furthest parking lot. We'll meet on the bridge - just behind the vehicle gate next to the parking lot. We'll hike as a group to an area known as Little Yosemite due to its large granite boulders and babbling creek. After snacks and a bit of exploring, we'll head back to the parking lot. Hiking, running, or other closed-toed shoes are recommended.
